We should than only use the funds that we have received through contributions with special Board approval for the particular purpose designated."

 - Alternative Language for consideration submitted by Chairperson Schuyler:
 " '1 a. Reside in Mason County and graduate from a public or non-public school located in Mason County, b. Graduate from and reside within the boundaries of a public or private accredited school located in Mason County.'

I believe this language includes all of the resident graduates that we are required to include as well as those who reside within their school district but outside of Mason County without opening the door to school of choice or home school and without having to amend the plan every time a school is added or dissolves in Mason County. The first part (1a) also mirrors the statute."
